**Below Left:** The first child to come into HOPE was Sravanthi, who came in 1998 at just under 3 years old. Now she's 23, married to a nice believer, and just had her first baby on July 19th. They gave the baby a long Telugu name that I don't remember, but they call him Alan. **Pray** for Sravanthi and her family. **Below Right:** Precious HOPE School girls, the boys on the back page. This is only the 1st through 7th grade girls, as the nursery and kindergarten children are not required to wear the white uniforms. Continue to **pray** for the HOPE School, attendance somewhat down from last year.







**SUBBAMMA:** 75 or above, and a widow. She has one son. This son wasted all the family money. She was living with him before coming to HOPE, but he wasn't caring for her. When her husband was still alive, he left the home because of family problems or disputes to stay in an old age home. Perhaps he wasn't able to work was why he wasn't welcome in the home. Subbamma was still able to work, so was allowed to stay. Her husband died, and the nursing home didn't even inform her! When he was alive, she was afraid to confess Christ because they were all Hindus. After his death, she had the boldness to take baptism. Her son became angry and made her leave, so she came to HOPE. Often she has expressed the desire to go and be with our Lord JESUS in glory.



**MANGAMMA (Chundi):** More than 80, a widow for many years. Has 1 son & 3 daughters, and another son who died. Only one daughter is still in this Chundi village. Mangamma has lived in this tarp-covered hut for many years, a Hindu temple next door. Some of our ministry friends within the Gospel Band, Brother Puthra and his father Samuel, were doing some street preaching in this area, and Mangamma started coming to the church around 2013. She's taken baptism and seems to have some understanding, but now is mostly deaf and has trouble walking, so she's not attending the services, the church building perhaps 1/2 kilometre away. A beautiful thing that a woman in her late 70's would come to the Lord! Hallelujah! **Pray for the pastor, Samuel.** He has had a stroke recently, which has left him partially paralyzed on one side of his body. He's recovering well, but wants to preach!



**LEFT:** Another of the 7 prisoners has been released on bail, here with his wife and 4 of 6 children. For reasons I still don't understand, though the Supreme Court of India ordered his "bail", he must again fight the case at the state level. **Pray** for his case, and for the other 5 believers who are still in prison.



**LEFT:** Enlarged the photos so you could see a little bit of their beautiful faces, putting the boys on one page and the girls on the other. The HOPE School uniform colors are actually blue and yellow, but many schools have had the tradition for years to wear white uniforms on Wednesdays. **Pray** for these precious boys (7 of them being HOPE boys), that the Christian influence in the school will have an eternal impact on all their lives, and **pray** also for their academic achievement. "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it." Proverbs 22:6. Though not our own children, we still have hope that His Words will transform their lives.
