**Above:** We rejoice that after many difficulties, finally the girls we've been assisting in a more volatile part of India have moved into a new facility. The girls (and others) are praying for the Lord's blessing as they move in.



**Left: ANUSHA** (9 years old, HOPE). Anusha is a very sweet girl, very strong for her age and size, and has many times demonstrated, with tears, a tender heart for the Lord. Her mother died after being given the wrong blood type during a transfusion after giving delivery to Anusha's little brother. The father then abandoned the family.

**Right: GANI** (9 years old, HOPE). Gani's real name is Ganesh, named after the elephant head idol you may have seen in various places, very famous in India. We nicknamed him Gani. His father left the family when Gani was small, leaving the mother in a desperate situation. Now studying 5th grade.



**Below: Birthdays at HOPE.** At left are the HOPE boys showing their "greetings" (like handmade birthday cards) to Gopi, the boy in a different shirt. Gopi turned 12 on October 17th. He's always been a very sweet-natured boy. **Pray he'll stay that way.** He's now in the 6th grade. At right are small HOPE girls giving their greetings to Sruthi (2nd from right), who turned 8 on September 21st. She's now in the 2nd grade. **Pray for her,** as she is more susceptible to fevers.







**Left: NARSAMMA (KB Palem):** Narsamma's husband is still alive, but very thin and emaciated. She's at least 60 (she has no idea her age). Does little works for some income. Has 4 children, but claims none of them help their parents. She just started coming to the local church recently, and has little knowledge of GOD. **Pray for her salvation** as we and the pastor there try to minister to her and her husband. She also receives no widows pension or rations of rice, so is more poor than most. Her husband cannot work.

**Right: LAKSHMAMMA (Singarayakonda):** In her 70's or older, her husband dying around 2000. Her son and daughter are not caring for her, so she's renting a house. Uses the support we give her for her extra needs, such as clothes, vegetables, medicine, etc. The govt. pension she uses for her rent and other food. She seems to be solid in Christ. *"For the needy will not always be forgotten, nor the hope of the afflicted perish forever."* Psalms 9:18



**Left:** As part of the widows & elderly ministry which we're a part of in many villages, there is also a literacy program which Brother Raju, and sometimes another young man named Livingstone, are conducting in 5 different villages. We're so thankful for the elderly who are having the desire to learn! As you can see on the left, in KB Palem quite a few children are also attending, who are not usually going to school. **Right:** Some of the elderly doing literacy class in the village of Chinthayapalem.



**Left: Ramanamma** from the village of YR Palem had some kind of gas problem, and died today. But we don't think of it as a sad thing if we're confident of their relationship with Christ. When we think of the contrast between this corrupt world and the glories of eternity with our Creator, why should we be sad for that person? Another elderly man who was part of this elderly ministry, Subba Rao from MR Nagar, also passed away a week or 2 ago. **Pray for their families.** **Right: Samrajyamma**, who is part of the HOPE Manna Program. She's in near 80 and part of HMP for many years. Her husband died about 40 years ago, and her only son also died. She has had serious asthma for years. **Please pray for her.** *"The Lord is near to the brokenhearted..."* Psalms 34:18



**Left:** These widows we've had the blessing of helping for a few years now (RHM channeling the funds to them from their sponsor). All of these women had husbands who were killed in persecution, some of them being pastors. The ministry we're connected with there is the same ministry which runs the girls home on the front page. And if you've been reading our newsletters and updates, and retaining some of the info, you'll remember the 7 men unjustly in prison for a murder they did not commit. This same ministry is helping the men's families. Two of the men have now been released this year, after 10 long years in prison. The other 5 continue to wait for their hearing before the India Supreme Court. **Please pray.**
